Jacques Archambault, the ancestor of the very vast majority of Archambault of all America, was present in Ville-Marie in 1651. He established there at the request of Paul Chomedey de Maisonneuve, founder of Montreal. He thus lived with the first Montrealers: Jeanne Mance, Marguerite Bourgeois, Lambert Closse, Dollard des Ormeaux to speak only about some of the most known. At the request of Maisonneuve, Jacques Archambault dug the first well of Ville-Marie. On this occasion, the Association of Archambault of America intends to organize a gathering of all Archambault to make known our ancestor and its role among the first Montrealers. We shall make an appointment with you around the replica of the well of our ancestor, near Pointe-à-Callière, in Old-Montreal, on September 10th, 2017.
